The amenities and facilities remain open for business and are at your disposal.

The main campus lodge has a golf driving range, a disc golf course, pickle ball, a pool, cabin rentals, and an RV park.

There are two available pavilions for rent at McCormick Lake.

The McCormick Lake house is available for special occasions with a maximum occupancy of 96.

You may also rent fishing boats, fun yaks, and canoes for enjoyment on McCormick Lake.

If you have your own boat, we have a concrete ramp on Compass Lake and offer monthly boat docking for a reasonable fee.

McCormick Lake has a gated ramp area. Property owners may purchase a gate key at the office. Noteno gasoline engines and no wake for electric engines allowed on McCormick Lake.

The pool at the lodge is open during the summer months for most days until 5pm. Please sign in at the office. Call ahead of time to make sure the pool is open and to make an appointment..
